## Medication Use Reviews (MURS) & New medicine Service (NMS)

## **Electronic Prescription Service**

We are now offering our customers the Electronic Prescription Service, which allows you to nominate a pharmacy to get your medication from. Your GP will then send your prescription electronically to the place you have nominated, saving you time, giving you more choice about where to collect your prescription from and is therefore more convenient.

## <u>Free Collection and Delivery Prescription</u> Service
